## International Poster Competition & Exhibition Amateur Category

The **GLS Institute of Design** proudly presents its **International Poster Competition & Exhibition** for amateur designers and creative enthusiasts. This competition is part of the **Open Design Dimensions (ODD) event**, providing a global platform for creatives to showcase their talents through Poster Design.

With a theme centered around “**India 2047**”, participants are encouraged to envision India's future, tapping into their creative and design potential.

### 1. Introduction of the Poster Competition

The competition invites amateur designers and creative individuals from India and abroad who are eager to express their vision for “**India in 2047**”. The competition encourages imaginative thinking, creative expression, and a visionary outlook toward India's development and future. It promises recognition, prizes, and an exhibition opportunity to showcase the best work.

### 2. Eligibility

This category is open to **amateurs, design enthusiasts, and creative individuals under the age of 28**. Participants from **universities, colleges, other higher education institutions, graduates, and professionals** working in any domain across India and abroad can submit their entries, provided they meet the age criterion.

### 3. Submission Guidelines

After a few days of registration, all participants will receive an email with submission details and a link. The submission must be made online via the link in the email using the same registration details and email address. Make sure the submission is done according to the guidelines given below.

Participants must submit their entries in the following format:

- **For submission entry, the participant has to submit one A2-sized poster** and a **short write-up** explaining the design concept behind the poster.
- **File Format:** PDF
- File Name should be in following format **FirstName\_LastName\_PosterTitle**
- **Maximum File Size:** 20 MB
- **Poster Size:** A2 (16.5 inch x 23.4 inch) - Vertical Only
- **Resolution:** 300 dpi, high-resolution poster for exhibition and printing purposes.
- **No Watermarks:** The Poster must not contain any watermarks or other identifiers.

**Note:**

- You can create the poster either with analog or digital tools.
- Only one entry per application can be considered.

**4. Important Dates**

- **Submission Deadline:** The deadline for submissions is **December 15th, 2024**.
- **Announcement of Selection:** Selected entries will be notified by **December 25th, 2024** via email and WhatsApp
- **Event and Exhibition of the selected entries is on 11th & 12th of January 2025.**
- **Declaration of Winners and Award Ceremony:** **12th of January 2025** during the closing ceremony on the final day of the exhibition at GLSID campus, Ahmedabad.

**5. Entry Fees**

The Participation Fee for entry into each Competition Category is **Rs. 500 (USD 6)** for the Amateur Category, and it must be paid online during entry submission. After registration, participants will receive an email with their Participation ID, Payment Details, and Submission Link.

**6. Copyright Declaration**

All participants must submit a signed **Copyright Declaration** affirming that the photograph is original and does not infringe on any third-party intellectual property rights. If any copyrighted material is used, participants must have proper licensing and provide proof upon request. This declaration will be provided to the participant after registration and through email along with submission and payment information. Any breach of copyright mentioned in the declaration will result in disqualification, and any awarded prizes will be revoked.

Participants grant GLS University **non-exclusive rights** to print, display, and exhibit their photographs at the event, on the GLSID website, and at associated festivals.
